Find the Valley Trail entrance in the Kingswood Development off of Handle Rd. One member of your team must hike the Valley Trail and find the volunteer who will be waiting with your next clue.

Choose one member of your team to complete challenge. This team member cannot be the one who completed the last challenge.

Did you know that the Blueberry Festival is July 31st – August 9th? Dover's even going to have a parade! Make your way to the Snow Mountain Market on Route 100 in West Dover. One member of your team must eat an entire blueberry pie before you get your next clue.

TEAM CHALLENGE

Got your sea legs on?

Head to West Wardsboro, VT, take Stratton-Arlington Rd to Forest Rd 262 to Grout Pond. Go all the way to the end and park in the parking lot. Head down to the water. One member of the team must paddle out and look for the volunteer in a kayak who will give you your next clue.

In the mean time the rest of the team must take the Pond Trail to the designated picnic table where the kayaker will meet their team. The entire team must take the kayak back to the start of the challenge.

Normal Rockwell – The Great American
Illustrator

USE CAUTION – Rough road ahead!

Go back out to the Stratton-Arlington Rd. which turns into Kelly Stand Rd. Continue to Arlington. When you get to the end of the road, turn left and follow the road into Arlington. You know you're going in the right direction when you see an old Army tank on your left at the Railroad crossing. You should be on East. Arlington Rd.

Norman Rockwell lived in Arlington in the 1940's and 50's. From Route 7A, take a left on Route 313 West, go approximately 4 miles and look for the West Arlington Covered Bridge. Go through the bridge and park at the Methodist Church. Make your way up the hill to the front lawn of the Inn at Covered Bridge Green to get your next clue.

TEAM CHALLENGE

The Lincoln Family Home

Make your way to Manchester, VT to the home of Robert Todd Lincoln, son of Abraham Lincoln. Drive to the Welcome Center and park in the main parking lot. Go into the Welcome Center to sign in at the counter and get your quiz. The answers to the questions will be in a short 6 minute movie about the Lincoln Family. You must watch the entire movie to get all of the answers but beware the movie only replays every 15 minutes.

When you think you have the answers follow the path up to the house and head to stone wall of the garden overlook. The volunteer there will verify your answers and give you your next clue. If you are incorrect you must proceed back down and start again.

ROADBLOCK

Are you ready for a thrill ride?

Your next stop is Bromley Sun Mountain Adventure Park. On Route 11 follow the sign that says Bromley Mountain parking 500ft. Park in the MAIN LOT before the tunnel. Sign in with the volunteer and get your ticket. One team member is going for a ride on the Alpine Slide. All team members now proceed to the Alpine chairlift where there will be another volunteer.

This volunteer will have a liability form which you must sign. Get in line to take the chair lift to the top of the Alpine Slide. This challenge is intended to be performed at a safe speed and going too fast will cause serious injury. Once you get to the bottom you'll receive your next clue.

**TEAM CHALLENGE
The West River Valley**

Find your way to The Townshend Dam. Park in the lot near the road and find The West River Trail. Take the stone steps down and head towards the Dam where you will find the volunteer who has your next clue.

TEAM CHALLENGE - Stop #1 Scott Covered Bridge

Just down the road a piece is the Scott Covered Bridge. Find it and take a picture of the entrance and sign. Show this at your very next stop.

ROADBLOCK - Stop #2 Raise your hand if you like teddy bears!

Choose one member of your team to complete challenge.

Choose one member of your team to complete challenge

Head on down to The Adams Family Farm in Wilmington. Once you arrive, sign in with the volunteer at the Horse Barn. One member of your team must pickup an old sap bucket and follows the marked path up to "The Cabin in the Woods". Once you arrive a volunteer will direct you to your filling station. You must fill up your bucket and make your way back to the Horse Barn with at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the water still in it to receive your next clue.

Feeling Lucky?

Make your way to the mini golf building at The North Star Bowl in Wilmington. Each team member must get a ball and club from the volunteer. Teams must choose which hole to play on; Hole #1 or Hole #16 and stick with it. Each team member must try to get a hole in one. If all 4 team members fail you must join the back of the line of the same hole and try again. The first person to get a hole in one for the team in will get their next clue.

Choose one member of your team to complete challenge

Go to the Grand Opening of Honora Winery which is situated along the North River in Jacksonville. Go to the table near the gazebo to start your challenge. One member of your team must take a Dixie cup and run to the pond, fill it up, bring it back and pour it into your wine bottle. Do this until the bottle is full and you will receive your next clue.

Eat at Dots

Choose one member of your team to complete challenge.

Head to Dot's of Wilmington, this may be tricky but it will be a treat! You must find parking along Main St. somewhere or in the municipal lot. YOU CANNOT park behind the building. All team members must be present – no dropping off! One member of your team must eat an entire Ice Cream Sundae before receiving your next clue.
